WHAT YOU AND I SHOULD BRING TO THE GOSPEL MEETING

Our gospel meeting with John Shannon begins today. We trust that this meeting has been in your heart, in your prayers, in your plans and on your lips and that you are anxious for the opportunities it will bring. Following is a list of some things that you and I should bring to the meeting.

1. **Ourselves.** As members of this congregation, you and I should feel a keen sense of responsibility to attend this meeting. Too many seem to feel that gospel meetings are unimportant and optional. Why, if they attend one or maybe two services, they have surely done all that should be expected of them (read James 4:17). It hurts and hinders the work of the church when Christians will not even attend such meetings at the congregation where they are members.
2. **Our hearts.** We need to be present in spirit as well as in body. Remember that acceptable worship must be "in spirit and in truth" (Jn. 4:24). "Set your affections on things above (Col. 3:1,2) and come with a fervent desire to praise God and reap the spiritual benefits this meeting will offer.
3. **Our Bibles.** God's work is our lamp and light (Psa. 119:105). God's word is the Christian's companion and guide (Psa. 1:2). It is good to form the habit of taking your Bible to every service along with paper and pen in order to take notes.
4. **Our voices.** An important part of our worship to God is the singing. Any preacher will tell you that good, enthusiastic singing enhances the preaching.
5. **Our smiles.** This may seem like a small, insignificant matter, but friendliness should be characteristic of Christians. We should greet one another and certainly our visitors with genuine warmth, showing sincere gratitude for their presence and exhibiting true interest in them.
6. **Our friends, relatives, and neighbors.** Let us not be guilty of deciding who will and will not come to the meeting without inviting them! Let them decide whether or not they will come. You and I have to do the inviting. Others cannot come if they do not know about the meeting. Remember, "he that winneth souls is wise" (Prov. 11:30).
